

Radiance Community Pool Rules

Please note:	Please follow these rules:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swim season starts first Saturday in May, ends October 31 2008. Hours of operation are dawn to 10 pm. Silent swimming is fine any time. • Rinse feet of grass, etc. before entering pool. • <i>Your key is intended for use by pool members, your family and guests only—no duplication please.</i> Replacement of lost key fees: \$10 first time, \$30 subsequent. Key shall be returned at end of season to the Pool Manager by second Saturday in November) by mail or drop box; call for instructions (contact info below). RPOA reserves the right to request the return of the key for just cause including, but not limited to, failure of member, member's family, or member's pool guests to abide by the rules. Pool membership fees will not be refunded in this event. • Member is responsible for repairs or replacement of any damaged or missing Community Pool property whether such damage or loss occurred intentionally or unintentionally by member, member's family, or member's guests. • We recommend that no one swim at the pool alone. <i>Member, member's family, and member's guests swim at their own risk</i> and release and waive Radiance Property Owner's Association (RPOA) and Radiance residents from any liability due to injury or changes occurring to member, member's family, and member's guests property or persons. Further, member shall indemnify the RPOA and Radiance residents against damages by others resulting from this pool membership. Any accidents/injuries which may occur will be the member's sole responsibility. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No rough or disruptive play. • No pets. • No glass containers, glass bottles, glass drinkware, pyrex or glass bowls/lids during potlucks, etc. • No alcohol. • No smoking. • No sunscreen/block or lotion in the water. Apply sunscreen at home, wait 45 minutes for it to soak into your skin (just like the instructions say on the bottle), then shower off any remainder before entering pool water. Failure to follow these steps means we must add more chlorine to your pool water. • No sharing your pool key with neighbors, friends, etc. Please ask them to become a pool member instead and pay a fair share. Membership fees pay for pool chemicals, pool maintenance, pool insurance, pool electric bills and more. We can't operate the pool without income. • Children under 12 may not operate the gate lock. • No unchaperoned children under age 12. • No "parties" at the pool without contacting the pool manager at least 24 hours beforehand. A "party" is defined here as a group of 10 people or more who you are responsible for, who will either use the pool(s) or the outhouse or both within a 1 to 4-hour time period.
