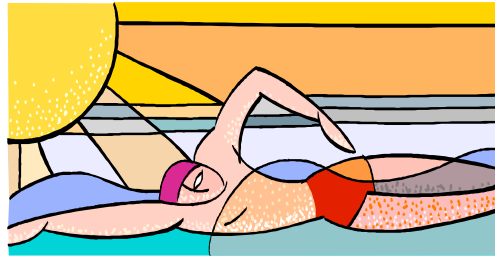

How to keep pool water clean, and membership fees and pool chemicals to a minimum

Attached please find our pool *User's Guide*. Please read it and make sure all guests and family members understand it well. With everyone's help, our pool's operating costs and membership fees can be kept to a minimum.

Our pledge to your health

Every year we do our best to offer you a clean, healthy pool environment, including:

- as always, a complete change out of last year's pool water for new water.
- use of natural oils and other biological controls to keep insects in check, so you and your family and guests can feel free to walk our grounds in good conscience. Want to find out more about organic controls for fire ants etc.? Just ask.
- avoiding use of algaecides our pool water. Our chemistry is mostly chlorine, hard work, and a carbon-silver cartridge (see <http://www.nature2.com/>) that removes the smell and feel of chlorine. You might be surprised to learn what chemical controls are used in the water at other pools!
